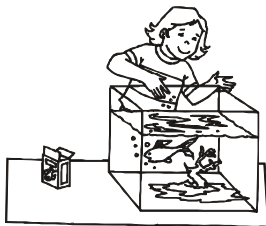


The verb "to have got"

<u>Long forms:</u>	<u>Short forms:</u>
I have got a book.	→ I've got a book.
You have got a book.	→ You've got a book.
He <u>has</u> got a book.	→ He's got a book.
She <u>has</u> got a book.	→ She's got a book.
It <u>has</u> got a book.	→ It's got a book.
We have got a book.	→ We've got a book.
You have got a book.	→ You've got a book.
They have got a book.	→ They've got a book.

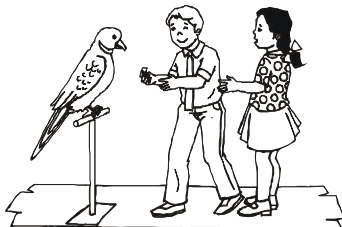
